Annie Le entered

Activated by ID cards



Record everyone
entering locked rooms



Electronic lock

Tracked Annie Le's movement through building



Last room entered was G13

Search of G13



Medium velocity
blood spatter

Police Investigation

Building extensively searched



Found her body in a wall space on 13 Sept.

Annie Le

Strangled

Jaw bone and collar bone broken

Bruising

Signs of sexual assault

Questions

What made Raymond Clark the suspect?



CCTV and electronic lock records

Evidence

CCTV showed him entering the building

Electronic locks



Clark was rushing from room to room



Looking for places to hide Annie Le's body?

Evidence

CCTV showed that he had changed his clothes

During the search of the building



Clark behaved suspiciously

Evidence

Arrest based on suspicion

Conviction based on proof



How was Raymond Clark convicted?

Evidence

Sock, glove and clothes found hidden above a ceiling tile



Blood from Raymond Clark and Annie Le was found on the sock

Evidence

In the wall space



Found a second sock and a green pen

Clark's DNA found on pen

Evidence

DNA evidence from sexual assault



Raymond Clark's DNA
